The following are The Weekly Highlights for The Manchester Community Schools for The Week of March 1, 2021:

1. Our Wednesday Schedules for The Month of March in the MCS!

During the required monthly review of the Manchester Community Schools COVID-19 Extended Learning Plan, the MCS Board of Education voted in favor of amending the learning plan and move to an In-Person status on Wednesdays for all of our In-Person students. All Remote Learning students will remain virtual on these Wednesday's, but will log-on to all required courses and class periods according to their weekly schedules for the week and for Wednesdays. We will return to In-Person Wednesdays for our In-Person students on the following dates:

The **Klager Elementary** Schedule will consist of the same time period as Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, with our Klager learners having a change in their Specials rotation. Starting Monday, March 1st, they will begin an A/B rotation for specials with our five full in-person learning days according to the following schedule:

Riverside Intermediate School will be conducting school according to their regular time schedule, with the same Specials Rotation as the Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday schedules. It's another day of school, with the exception of an additional STEM section created for our 5th and 6th grade Band students on an every other week basis.

The **Manchester Jr./Sr. High School** schedule will continue their Periods 1-4 rotation during the first week of the 5-Day per-week in-person instruction and the 5-7 rotation during the second week of 5-Day per-week in-person instruction. The schedule for March is as follows:

Wednesday, March 3rd: 1st-4th period

Wednesday, March 10th: 5th, Advisory, 6th and 7th period

Wednesday, March 17th: 1st-4th period

Wednesday, March 24th: 5th, Advisory, 6th, and 7th period

Our students will attend all four classes on each of these days with the same time period as our Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday schedules.
