2. Welcome Back Students!

On Monday, December 21, 2020, the Manchester Community Schools Board of Education voted unanimously to reconfirm the Manchester Community Schools Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan. This action, along with the December 18th State of Michigan Department of Health and Human Services order, allows for the return of all

Pre-Kindergarten through 12th Grade In-Person students to In-Person learning beginning Monday, January 4, 2021. Our Remote Learning students will continue their engagement with the Remote platform. This action also confirmed the Virtual Wednesday, asynchronous instruction format to continue for all students on Wednesday, January 6, Wednesday, January 13, and Wednesday, January 20, 2021. The MCS Board of Education will then vote again on the reconfirmation of the plan and status of the asynchronous Wednesday instruction at their next Board of Education meeting on Monday, January 25, 2021.
