SUPERINTENDENT REPORT - Dr. Bezeau congratulated the equestrian team for making it to regionals, Armstrong added it was their 13th year making it. NWEA will begin soon for K-8th grades. Homecoming is the week of the 26th-30th and there will be a parade at 4:30pm and he invites all staff and students to walk in it. We are working through Consortium to get a 15 passenger van for the smaller Athletic teams to use. Transportation is filling the positions and having interviews for candidates to meet our goal of 5 drivers, thanked the public for being patient with the driving routes we have currently.


